Carpenter Assistant (Roofing Team)

The Carpenter Assistant, under the direct supervision of the Carpenter and the Director of Restoration/Maintenance, is a seasonal position responsible for undertaking work in accordance with the maintenance program of the Museum and will perform a variety of work in the restoration and repair of buildings and grounds of Sherbrooke Village.

Carpentry teams will focus on roofing and roof repairs using cedar shingles for the 2024 Season.

Position: 40 hours per week – Seasonal with entitlement to annual recall

Salary: \$22.00 per hour, plus 4% vacation pay, and 2% in lieu of benefits

Start Date: May 6, 2024, for an expected 24 weeks of employment

Qualifications:

The successful candidate must have:

- Ability to endure physically demanding outdoor work, including climbing scaffolds, lifting, and working at heights and on uneven surfaces.
- Demonstrated experience and understanding of proper construction and maintenance techniques, including shingling, painting, levelling, repair and/or replacing floor joists, beams, interior and exterior wall covering, windows, doors, wooden walkways, etc.
- Demonstrated knowledge of safety regulations.
- Valid driver's license.
- Able to lift heavy objects up to and exceeding 22.7 kg (50 lbs).
- Minimum 2 years Carpentry experience desired; Carpentry/Journeyman papers and/or Red Seal considered an asset.

Skills considered an asset are:

- Knowledge of building techniques, materials and safe operating procedures.
- Knowledge of heritage restoration carpentry and preventative maintenance.
- Completion of safety courses, such as WHMIS & First Aid.
- Ability to work cooperatively with team members and other staff on site.
- Ability to communicate in a courteous manner with peers, visitors and guests.
- Experience with the Nova Scotia Museum system and the provincial tourism industry.
