Senior Interpreter (Hands on History)

Full time seasonal position

The Hands-on History program at Sherbrooke Village is vital in bringing 1860's experiences to the visitors we serve. Daily events include dressing visitors, children's parades, hymn singing, story telling, craft making, and participating in artisan and farming activities. The Senior Interpreter is responsible for daily participation in such events as well as orchestrating the schedule and structure of the group to make it happen. This person will work closely with the Supervisor of Interpretation (Hands on History) to ensure the vision from management is demonstrated by the group. The senior interpreter is also expected to facilitate the collective generation of ideas and to present these to management.

Position: This is a full time seasonal position, normally 17+ weeks in duration.
