Senior Interpreter (Living History)

The Living History Interpretation group is a vital part of bringing Sherbrooke Village to life. Strong interpretation of characters and activities associated with buildings within the museum will be implemented to immerse the visitor in an authentic 1860's experience. The Senior Interpreter will be responsible for demonstrating leadership among co-workers to achieve a consistent offering of outstanding visitor experience. The Senior Interpreter will not only lead by example but will inspire and hold accountable the others in this group. The Senior Interpreter in the Living History functional area will work closely with Rovers and HOH interpreters and ensure the vision for the museum is kept top of mind and fully implemented by the Living History group of interpreters.

Position: This is a full time seasonal position, normally 17 weeks in duration.
